REHABILITATION

Peamount provides consultant led interdisciplinary post-acute specialist inpatient rehabilitation services for adults with neurological, respiratory and age related medical conditions.

Age Related Rehabilitation

Peamount supports rehabilitation needs for patients over age 65 years following stroke, fractures, falls or following an illness.

Respiratory Rehabilitation

Peamount offer integrated care services for inpatients and outpatients to include diagnostic pulmonary function and sleep studies.

Neuro Rehabilitation

Peamount provides dedicated Neurorehabilitation beds for individuals under 65 years who experience a new onset acute neurological injury including stroke, traumatic brain injury, neuromuscular and neuroinflammatory disorders. Our aim is to restore quality of life and improve independence.



RESIDENTIAL

Older Persons Service

Older residents living in Peamount are supported and enabled to maintain their independent, physical and mental wellbeing.

Neurological Service

Residential services are provided to people with a neurological disability within St. Brid's Unit. This is a highly specialised unit for people with traumatic and progressive neurological disabilities.

INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY

Peamount provides disability care and support services in line with 'Transforming Lives programme' which sets out the delivery of personalised health and social care services based on the principles of self-determination and autonomy.

Ageing Intellectual Disability

Peamount provides an intellectual disability service to individuals that are ageing, many with complex health and social care needs both on campus and within the community.

Health & Wellbeing

Peamount is committed to ensuring residents social needs are supported within the local community and on the campus in the resource/activities Health & Wellness Centre.



COMMUNITY

Primary Care and Out Patient Services

Peamount provides primary care services for patients referred by GPs in the Dublin West, Kildare and Meath area.
